

GDPR PRIVACY NOTICE FOR PARTICIPANTS

BOPS Academy 2026

1. Data Controller

Basell Orlen Polyolefins Sprzedaż Sp. z o.o., with its registered office in Płock at ul. Łukasiewicza 39, 09-400 Płock ("BOPS"), is the controller of your personal data. BOPS can be contacted by telephone at +48 24 364 74 74 or by email at sales@basellorlen.pl.

2. Data Protection Officer

For matters relating to the processing of personal data and the exercise of rights under the GDPR, you may contact the Data Protection Officer by email at IOD@basellorlen.pl or in writing at BOPS's registered office, marking the correspondence "Data Protection Officer".

3. Categories of personal data

In connection with registration for BOPS Academy 2026, BOPS processes the following personal data provided in the registration form:

- first and last name;
- email address;
- company or organisation name;
- job title or role.

4. Purposes and legal basis for processing

Your personal data will be processed for the following purposes:

- receiving and processing your application, verifying your registration and managing the list of participants in BOPS Academy 2026;
- communicating with you on organisational matters, including sending registration confirmations, information about the venue, date, programme, organisational changes and other notices necessary for participation in the event;
- ensuring the proper organisation, operation, security and accountability of the event;
- establishing, exercising or defending legal claims.

The legal basis for the processing is Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR, i.e. BOPS's legitimate interest in organising BOPS Academy 2026, handling registration and communicating with participants, ensuring the proper conduct of the event, and establishing, exercising or defending legal claims.

Under this notice, the data will not be used to send marketing communications unrelated to the organisation of BOPS Academy 2026.

5. Recipients of personal data

Your personal data may be disclosed to entities assisting BOPS with the organisation and operation of the event, in particular:

- providers and administrators of the website and registration form;
- providers of IT, hosting, email and technical support services;
- entities providing organisational, conference, logistics or communication services, solely to the extent necessary to deliver the event;
- law firms, auditors and advisers, where necessary to establish, exercise or defend legal claims;
- public authorities, where the disclosure of data is required by law.

Entities processing personal data on behalf of BOPS act under appropriate agreements and are required to ensure the protection of personal data.

6. Transfers outside the European Economic Area

In connection with BOPS's use of IT, hosting or communication services, personal data may be transferred to countries outside the European Economic Area. Such transfers will be made using the mechanisms provided for under the GDPR, in particular on the basis of a European Commission adequacy decision or standard contractual clauses, together with supplementary safeguards where required. Information about the safeguards applied may be obtained by contacting the Data Protection Officer.

7. Data retention period

Personal data will be processed for the period necessary to receive the application, organise, conduct and complete BOPS Academy 2026, and handle communications relating to the event. After the event, the data may be retained for the period necessary to establish, exercise or defend legal claims, as well as for any period required by law, where such obligations apply.

8. Rights of the data subject

You have:

- the right to access your data and obtain a copy;
- the right to rectify your data;
- the right to request the erasure of your data in the circumstances provided for by the GDPR;
- the right to request restriction of processing;
- the right to object to the processing on grounds relating to your particular situation, since the processing is based on BOPS's legitimate interest;
- the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.

The right to data portability does not apply to the processing described in this notice because the data is not processed on the basis of consent or a contract.

9. Voluntary provision of data and consequences of failure to provide it

Providing personal data is voluntary; however, it is necessary to register for and participate in BOPS Academy 2026. Failure to provide the required data will prevent BOPS from accepting your application, communicating with you on organisational matters and enabling your participation in the event.

10. Automated decision-making

Your personal data will not be used to make decisions based solely on automated processing, including profiling, which would produce legal effects concerning you or similarly significantly affect you.
